Founded on October 8, 1886, as the direct successor to the Chicago Stamp Collectors Union of 1884, the Chicago Philatelic Society (CPS) is one of the two organizations with the longest uninterrupted service to philately in the United States. In programs, in our annual exhibition CHICAGOPEX, and in other matters we are very much up to date. We meet monthly every third Thursday at 7:00pm for a short business meeting and a philatelic program by a member or guest.

CPS is Chapter No. 1 of the American Philatelic Society (APS). CPS members attending our meetings are able to connect with fellow members, hear about upcoming philatelic events and may listen and learn from speakers talking about a variety of stamp and postal history topics.

Each fall, CPS stages CHICAGOPEX, an annual national-level philatelic exhibition, which is part of the World Series of Philately. Its "national" status is recognized by the APS, and the winner of our open class becomes eligible to compete in the APS Champion of Champions competition. In addition, exhibitors receiving high awards are eligible to compete in international exhibitions under FIP rules. Members are encouraged to volunteer as part of the show committee.

An annual awards banquet is held at CHICAGOPEX. At its conclusion, exhibition medals and trophies are awarded, and the Newbury Award is announced (named after famed Chicago philatelist Saul Newbury and considered the most coveted award to a Chicagoland philatelist).

The *CPS Bulletin*, published monthly, is designed to keep the membership informed on our own and others' activities. There is usually a philatelic article included. Members are encouraged to provide information for inclusion in the *Bulletin*.

As philatelists, we have common interests. The Chicago Philatelic Society was founded for and is designed to help serve these interests. You owe it to yourself and to your hobby to join one of the oldest and most active stamp collectors clubs in Chicagoland.
